

Then, please sign (by your General Manager, Executive Director or other appropriate head of your agency), date and identify your organization at the bottom of the appropriate sheet. Please return the enclosure to the FTA Region 10 office at the above address. Please note ATTN: EARMARK on the envelope. Please also include a copy of any information submitted to Congress which states the purpose of the earmark.

Please note that these amounts shown in the attachment will be slightly reduced (approximately 1%) because of the recent rescission passed by Congress. A new Federal Register will be published soon with the correct amounts.

Finally, please understand that this correspondence is not a promise or obligation of the Government to award these grants. Full compliance with the Federal Transit Administration's grant process is still required. This Bulletin is intended merely as a tool to assist in that process.
